









BALI TOURISM POTENTIALS

Bali has been popular to the world as a tourist destination since 1920-s with Bali tourism potentials (the main reasons) foreign tourists visit Bali:

- 1. Unique culture (beautiful dances, rituals ceremonies, traditional activities and others)
- 2. Beautiful nature (sea, rivers, rice fields, mountains and many more)
- 3. Friendly people

And Bali has many names or brandings that are given by the tourists: the Island of Gods, the Island of Paradise, the Island of Love or the Morning of the World (Jawaharlal Nehru, 1954).

The Bali Province Government considers it is necessary to have a policy to protect those tourism potentials. That in 14th February 2024, every foreign tourist who visit Bali has to pay a Foreign Tourists Levy.

PURPOSE OF LEVY

The Foreign Tourist Levy will be used:

- a. to protect Bali culture including custom, traditions, art as well as local wisdom. The main priority in 2025 is **cultural preservations**.
- b. to manage Bali natural environment to be clean, beautiful, and sustainable. The main priority in 2025 is waste management.









POINTS OF THE FOREIGN TOURISTS LEVY

Who should pay?

Every Foreign Tourists who travelling to Bali

How much to pay?

Foreign Tourists are subject to a levy of Rp150,000.00 per person

How many times have to pay?

The levy is paid **only 1 (one) time** while traveling in Bali, before the tourist leaves the territory of Republic of Indonesia









POINTS OF THE FOREIGN TOURISTS LEVY

When to pay?

International tourists are strongly encouraged to make online payments before departure to Bali to ease procedure upon arrival at the Airport or Port in Bali or while enjoying the trip in Bali

How to pay?

Payments can be done;

- by accessing the Love Bali system before entering Bali (https://lovebali.baliprov.go.id)
- while traveling in Bali via Endpoints (hotels, travel agents, tourist attractions) in the Love Bali system.









POINTS OF THE FOREIGN TOURISTS LEVY

Proof of payment

Foreign Tourists will get a proof of payment in the form of Levy voucher with a QR Code that is sent to email from Love Bali system

Payment method

Payment can be done by Credit cards (Visa, Master Card, American Express and JCB), bank transfer, Virtual Account, and QRIS. (keep improving the payment system)

When it started?

Will be implemented from February 14, 2024

Foreign tourists fly directly to Bali









PAYMENT FLOW THROUGH ARRIVAL AT HARBOR

1. Ship agent submits a list of travelers who will embark in Bali through the LoveBali Endpoint system (passport number, name, email, arrival date).

Agent makes payment through LoveBali endpoint system



If the transaction process is successful, the Love Bali system will provide a paid notification and proof of payment to the Foreign Tourist in the form of a digital payment receipt.





Persons on Duty will check by scanning the QR Code











EXEMPTION FOR INTERNATIONAL TOURIST LEVY

Payment Exemptions are effective to:

- 1. Diplomatic and official visa holders;
- 2. Crew on transportation vehicles;
- 3. Holders of Temporary Stay Permit Card (KITAS) or Permanent Stay Permit Card (KITAP);
- 4. Family unification visa holders;
- 5. Student visa holders;
- 6. Golden visa holders;
- 7. And holders of other types of visas (type of business visa or others).














EXEMPTION FOR FOREIGN TOURIST LEVY

- 1. To get a levy payment exemption, Foreign Tourist must submit an application through the Love Bali system at least 5 (five) days before they enter the arrival doors in Bali.
- 2. If the submission is less than 5 (five) days, the Foreign Tourist is subject to levy.
















LEVY EXEMPTION APPLICATION FLOW
















Payment in Endpoint (Travel Agent, Accommodation, Tourism Attractions) Via Online Love Bali











Endpoint Payment Advise (Travel Agent, Accommodation, Tourism Attractions)







Sanctions for Foreign Tourists Who Do Not Pay Fees

Foreign Tourists who do not pay the levy are given administrative sanctions in the form of:

- 1. Verbal reprimand and recorded in the Love Bali System.
- 2. A written reprimand sent to the Representative Country Offices of the Foreign Tourist in Bali (Indonesia).
- 3. Do not get service at tourist attractions.
- 4. Report to Immigration Office for immigration action.
